I. ABILENE DEANERY

ABILENE DEANERY PARISHES AND BOUNDARIES

1. HOLY FAMILY, PARISH, ABILENE

This parish extends over the southwestern part of Taylor County.

Begin at the corner of S 1st St. and Sayles Blvd.; thence south on Sayles Blvd. until it becomes Buffalo Gap Rd.; southwest on Buffalo Gap Rd. to Highway #84; southeast on Highway #84 to the Taylor County Line; west on the Taylor County Line to the corner; north on the Taylor County Line to I-20; east on I-20 to Highway #385; south on Highway #385 to Highway #393; east on Highway #393 to Highway #360; south on Highway #360 to Highway #392; east on Highway #392 to Highway #1235; north on Highway #1235 to Highway #304; east on Highway #304 to Highway #287; north on Highway #287 to I-20; east on I-20 to Highway #84; southeast on Highway #84 until it becomes S 1st St; east on S 1st St. to Sayles Blvd, the point of beginning.

2. SACRED HEART, PARISH, ABILENE

STS JOACHIM & ANN, MISSION, CLYDE

This parish extends over the entirety of Callahan County and the eastern edge of Taylor County. Begin at the northeast corner of the Callahan County; thence south on the Callahan County Line to the corner; west on the Callahan County Line to Highway #84; north on Highway #84 until it becomes Highway #83; northwest on Highway #83 to Buffalo Gap Rd.; northeast on Buffalo Gap Rd. until it becomes Sayles Blvd.; north on Sayles Blvd. to S 1st St; east on S 1st St. to S Treadway Blvd.; northeast on S Treadway Blvd. to E Hwy. #80; east on E Hwy. #80 until it becomes I-20 Frontage Rd.; east on I-20 Frontage Rd. to the Callahan County Line; north on the Callahan County Line to the corner; east on the Callahan County Line to the corner, the point of beginning.

3. ST VINCENT PALLOTI, PARISH, ABILENE

OUR MOTHER OF MERCY, MISSION, MERKEL

This parish extends over the northwest section of Taylor County.

Begin at the intersection of the Taylor County Line and Bus Hwy #83; thence south on Bus Hwy #83 to S 1st St.; west on S 1st St. until it becomes Hwy #84; west on Hwy #84 to Hwy #287; south on Hwy #287 to Hwy #640; west on Hwy #640 to Hwy #1235; south on Hwy #1235 to Hwy #392; west on Hwy #392 to Hwy #360; north on Hwy #360 to Hwy #393; west on Hwy #393 to Hwy #385; north on Hwy #385 to Hwy #84; west on Hwy #84 to the west Taylor County Line; north on the Taylor County Line to the corner; east on the Taylor County Line to Bus Hwy #83, the point of beginning.

4. ST FRANCIS, PARISH, ABILENE

This parish extends over the northeast corner of Taylor County.

Begin at the northeast corner of the Taylor County; thence south on the Taylor County Line to I-20; west on I-20 Frontage Rd until it becomes E Hwy #80; west on E Hwy #80 to Bus Hwy #83; north on Bus Hwy #83 to the Taylor County Line; east on the Taylor County Line to the corner, the point of beginning.

5. ST MARY QUEEN OF PEACE, PARISH, BROWNWOOD

This parish covers the entirety of Brown County.

6. SACRED HEART, PARISH, COLEMAN

OUR LADY OF MOUNT CARMEL, MISSION, WINTERS

This parish extends over the entirety of Coleman County and the northeastern portion of Runnels County.

Begin at the northeast corner of the Coleman County Line; thence south on the Coleman County Line to the corner; west on the Coleman County Line to the Corner; north on the Coleman County Line to Highway #153; west on Highway #153 to the Runnels County Line; east on the Runnels County Line to the northeastern corner of the Coleman County Line, the point of beginning.

7. ST ANN, PARISH, COLORADO CITY

ST JOSEPH, MISSION, LORAINE

This parish extends over the entirety of Mitchell County.

8. HOLY SPIRIT, PARISH, SWEETWATER

This parish extends over the entirety of Nolan County.

ST ISIDORE, MISSION, COYANOSA

This parish covers the entirety of Crane County and the northwest part of Pecos County.

Begin at the intersection of the north Crane County Line and the east Crane County Line; thence south on the Crane County line to the south Crane County Line; west on the Crane County Line to Hwy #1053; south on Hwy #1053 to Grand St.; south east on Grand St. to 1st St.; southwest on 1st St. to Imperial St.; south east on Imperial St. to 3rd St.; south west on 3rd St. to Prairie Rd; northwest on Prairie Rd to Hwy #1053; southwest on Hwy #1053 to Hwy #1450; northwest on Hwy #1450 to Hwy #1776; south on Hwy #1776 to Frank St.; east and then south on Frank St. to Gamboa Rd; east on Gamboa Rd to Battleland St.; south on Battleland St. to Putnam St.; west on Putnam St. to Frank St.; south on Frank St. to Mallory St.; west on Mallory St. to Battle St.; north on Battle St. to Farabee St.; west on Farabee St. to Hwy #1776; south on Hwy #1776 to Hwy #285; northwest on Hwy #285 to the Pecos County Line; north east on the Pecos County Line to the corner; southeast on the Pecos County Line to the Crane County Line; north on the Crane County Line to the north Crane County Line; east on the Crane County Line to the east Crane County Line, the point of beginning.

4. OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE, PARISH, FORT STOCKTON

This parish covers the majority of Pecos County.

Begin at the intersection of Highway #1053 and the north Pecos County Line; thence southeast on the Pecos County Line to Highway #349; south on Highway #349 to Kniveton St; south on Kniveton St to E 4th St; east on E 4th St to Harte St; south on Harte St to W 3rd St; east on W 3rd St to Blanton St; south on Blanton St to W 2nd St; east on W 2nd St to Hallmark St; south on Hallmark St to Underwood St; north on Underwood St to Highway #190; south east on Highway #190 to the Pecos County Line; south on the Pecos County Line to Interstate 10; northwest on Interstate 10 to Highway #349; southeast on Highway #349 to Ave K; south on Ave K to Southern St; east on Southern St to Highway #349; south west on Highway #349 to the Pecos County Line; west on the Pecos County Line across the southern and up the western side of the county to Hwy #285; southeast on Hwy #285 to Highway #1776; north on Highway #1776 to Farabee Rd; east on Farabee Rd to Battle St; south on Battle St to Mallory St; east on Mallory St to Frank St; north on Frank St to Putnam St; east on Putnam St to Battleland St; north on Battleland St to Gamboa Rd; west on Gamboa Rd to Frank St; north on Frank St to Highway #1776; north on Highway #1776 to Highway #1450; east on Highway #1450 to Highway #1053; northwest on Highway #1053 to Prairie Rd; southeast on Prairie Rd to 3rd St; northeast on 3rd St to Imperial St; northwest on Imperial St to 1st St; northeast on 1st St to Grand St; northeast on

Grand St to Highway #1053; northeast on Highway #1053 to the Pecos County Line, the point of beginning.

5. SACRED HEART, PARISH, MCCAMEY

This parish covers the majority of Upton County.

Begin at the intersection of the north County Line of Upton County and Hwy #349; thence south on Hwy #349 to Hwy #2401; east on Hwy #2401 to Hwy #126; south and then east on Hwy #126 to the east Upton County Line; south on the Upton County Line to Hwy #67; west on Hwy #67 to 12th Ave; north on 12th Ave to Hwy #576; north on Hwy #576 to Hwy #349; north on Hwy #349 to Upton St.; south on Upton St. to 12th Ave; west on 12th Ave to William St.; north on William St. to 13th Ave; west on 13th Ave to Elizabeth St.; south on Elizabeth St. to 11th Ave; west on 11th Ave to Severn St.; south on Severn St. to 6th Ave; west on 6th Ave to Clara St; south on Clara St to Hwy #329; east on Hwy #329 to Hwy #67; southwest on Hwy #67 to Hwy #349; south on Hwy #349 to the south Upton County Line; west on the Upton County Line to the west Upton County Line; north on the Upton County Line to the north Upton County Line; east on the Upton County Line to Hwy #349, the point of beginning.

6. OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE, PARISH, MIDLAND

This parish covers the north central section of Midland County.

Begin at the intersection of the north Midland County Line and I-20; thence southwest on I-20 until it becomes Bus #20; southwest on Bus #20 to S Big Spring St.; north on S Big Spring St. to W Indiana Ave.; west on W Indiana Ave. to A St.; north on A St. to Wadley Ave.; east on Wadley Ave. to Big Spring St.; north on Big Spring St. to the north Midland County Line; east on the north Midland County Line to the intersection with I-20, the point of beginning.

7. SAN MIGUEL ARCANGEL, PARISH, MIDLAND

ST RITA OF CASCIA, MISSION, GREENWOOD

This parish covers the eastern half of Midland County.

Begin at the intersection of the north Midland County Line and the East Midland County Line; thence south on the East Midland County Line to the south Midland County Line; west on the south Midland County Line to Hwy #349; north on Hwy #349 to W County Rd. #180; west on W County Rd. #180 to S County Rd. 1210; north on S County Rd. #1210 until it becomes Midkiff Rd.; north on Midkiff Rd. to W Wall St.; north east on W Wall St. to Bus #20; northeast on Bus #20 until it becomes I-20; northeast on I-20 to the north Midland County Line; east on the north Midland County Line to the intersection with the East Midland County Line, the point of beginning.

8. ST ANN'S, PARISH, MIDLAND

This parish covers the northwestern central section of Midland County.

Begin at the intersection of the north Midland County Line and Big Spring St.; south on Big Spring St. to Wadley Ave.; west on Wadley Ave. to A St.; south on A St. to Indiana Ave.; east on Indiana Ave. to Big Spring St.; south on Big Spring St. to Bus #20; south west on Bus #20 to W Wall St.; southwest on W Wall St. to Midkiff Rd.; north on Midkiff Rd. to Mockingbird Ln.; west on Mockingbird Ln. to Midland Dr.; north on Midland Dr. to Greentree Blvd.; west on Greentree Blvd. to Holiday Hill Rd.; north on Holiday Hill Rd. to Hwy #349; northeast on Hwy #349 to the north Midland County Line; east on the north Midland County Line to Big Spring St., the point of beginning.

9. ST STEPHEN’S, PARISH, MIDLAND

This parish covers the western half of Midland County.

Begin at the intersection of the north Midland County Line and Hwy #349; thence southwest on Hwy #349 to Holiday Hill Rd.; south on Holiday Hill Rd. to Greentree Blvd.; east on Greentree Blvd. to Midland Dr.; south on Midland Dr. to Mockingbird Ln.; east on Mockingbird Ln. to Midkiff Rd.; south on Midkiff Rd. until it becomes S County Rd. #1210; south on S County Rd. #1210 to W County Rd. #180; east on W County Rd. #180 to Hwy #349; south on Hwy #349 to the south Midland County Line; west on the south Midland County Line to the west Midland County Line; north on the west Midland County Line to the north Midland County Line; east on the north Midland County Line to Hwy #349, the point of beginning.

10. HOLY REDEEMER, PARISH, ODESSA

OUR LADY OF SAN JUAN, MISSION, ODESSA

This parish covers the western section of Ector County.

Begin at the intersection of the north Ector County Line and Andrews Hwy.; thence south on Andrews Hwy. to Hwy #338; southeast on Hwy #338 to 87th St.; west on 87th St. to Dawn Ave.; south on Dawn Ave. to Yukon Rd.; west on Yukon Rd. to Andrews Hwy.; south on Andrews Hwy. until it becomes Grant Ave.; south on Grant Ave. to Bus #20; southwest on Bus #20 until it becomes I-20; southwest on I-20 to the south Ector County Line; west on the south Ector County Line to the west Ector County Line; north on the west Ector County Line to the north Ector County Line; east on the north Ector County Line to Andrews Hwy, the point of beginning.

11. ST. ANTHONY’S, PARISH, ODESSA

This parish covers the south-central section of Ector County.

Begin at the intersection of Bus #20 and Grant Ave.; thence south on Grand Ave. to the south Ector County Line; west on the south Ector County Line to I-20; northeast on I-20 until it becomes Bus #20; northeast on Bus #20 to Grand Ave., the point of beginning.

12. ST ELIZABETH ANN SETON, PARISH, ODESSA

This parish covers the northeastern corner of Ector County.

Begin at the intersection of the north Ector County Line and the east Ector County Line; thence south on the east Ector County Line to Bus #20; southwest on Bus #20 to John Ben Shepperd Pkwy; northwest on John Ben Shepperd Pkwy to University Blvd.; west on University Blvd. to Grandview Ave.; north on Grandview Ave. to 52nd St.; west on 52nd St. to Andrews Hwy.; north on Andrews Hwy. to Yukon Rd.; east on Yukon Rd. to Dawn Ave.; north on Dawn Ave. to 87th St.; east on 87th St. to Hwy #338; northwest on Hwy #338 to Andrews Hwy.; north on Andrews Hwy. to the north Ector County Line; east on the north Ector County Line to the east Ector County line, the point of beginning.

13. ST. JOSEPH’S, PARISH, ODESSA

ST. MARTIN DE PORRES, MISSION, ODESSA

This parish covers the southeast portion of Ector County.

Begin at the intersection of Bus #20 and the east Ector County Line; thence south on the east Ector County Line to the south Ector County Line; west on the south Ector County Line to Grant Ave.; north on Grant Ave. to Bus #20; northeast on Bus #20 to the east Ector County Line, the point of beginning.

14.ST. MARY’S, PARISH, ODESSA

This parish covers the middle portion of Odessa.

Begin at the intersection of 52nd St. and Grandview Ave.; thence south on Grandview Ave. to University Blvd.; east on University Blvd. to John Ben Shepperd Pkwy.; south on John Ben Shepperd Pkwy. to Bus #20; southwest on Bus #20 to Grant Ave.; north on Grant Ave. until it becomes Andrews Hwy.; north on Andrews Hwy. to 52nd St.; east on 52nd St. to Grandview Ave., the point of beginning.

15.ST JAMES, PARISH, SANDERSON

This parish covers the entirety of Terrell County.

16.ST LAWRENCE, PARISH, ST LAWRENCE

ST PASCAL, MISSION, STERLING CITY

ST THOMAS, MISSION, MIDKIFF

This parish extends over the entirety of Sterling County, the entirety of Glasscock County, and the northeastern edge of Upton County.

Begin at the north east corner of Sterling County; thence south on the Sterling County Line to the corner; west on the Sterling County Line to the corner; south on the Sterling County Line to the corner; north on the Sterling County Line to the Glasscock County Line; west on the Glasscock County Line to the corner; south on the Upton County Line to Hwy #126; west on Hwy #126 to Hwy #2401; west on Hwy #2401 to Hwy #349; north on Hwy #349 to the Upton County Line; east on the Upton County Line to the corner; north on the Glasscock County Line to the corner; east on the Glasscock County Line until it becomes the Sterling County Line; east on the Sterling County Line to the corner, the point of beginning.

17.ST JOSEPH, PARISH, STANTON

ST MARTIN, MISSION, LENORAH

This parish covers the entirety of Martin County.

Begin at the intersection of Highway #153 and the eastern Runnels County Line; thence south on the Runnels County Line to the corner, west on the Runnels County Line to Highway #83; north on Highway #83 to Highway #67; southwest on Highway #67 to Highway #2133; northwest on Highway #2133 to Highway #2111; northwest on Highway #2111 to Highway #158; northwest on Highway #158 to the Runnels County Line; south on the Runnels County Line to the southeast corner of Coke County; west on the Coke County Line to the corner; north on the Coke County Line to the corner; east on the Coke County Line to Highway #153; southeast on Highway #153 to the eastern Runnels County Line, the point of beginning.

2. ST MARGARET OF CORTONA, PARISH, BIG LAKE

ST FRANCIS OF ASSISI, MISSION, IRAAN

ST THOMAS, MISSION, RANKIN

This parish extends over the entirety of Reagan County, the northwest part of Crockett County, a small portion of Pecos County, and the southeast corner of Upton County.

Begin at the northeast corner of the Reagan County Line; thence south on the Reagan County Line to the corner, west on the Reagan County Line to Highway #33; south on Highway #33 to Highway #190; southwest on Highway #190 to Underwood St (In Iraan); south on Underwood St to Hallmark St; west on Hallmark St to E 2nd St; west on E 2nd St to Blanton St; north on Blanton St to W 3rd St; west on W 3rd St to Harte St; north on Harte St to E 4th St; west on E 4th St to Kniveton St; northwest on Kniveton St to Highway #190; west on Highway #190 to Highway #349; northwest on Highway #349 to the Crockett County Line; northwest on the Crockett County Line to the corner; east on the Crockett County Line to Highway #349; north on Highway #349 to Highway #67; northeast on Highway #67 to Highway #329; north west on Highway #329 to Clara St.; north on Clara St. to 6th Ave; east on 6th Ave to Severn St.; north on Severn St. to 11th Ave.; east on 11th Ave. to Elizabeth St.; north on Elizabeth St. to 13th Ave.; east on 13th Ave. to William St.; south on William St. to 12th Ave.; east on 12th Ave. to Upton St.; north on Upton St. to Highway #349; south on Highway #349 to Highway #567; southeast on Highway #567 to 12th Ave.; east on 12th Ave. to Highway #67; northeast on Highway #67 to the Upton County Line; north on the Upton County Line to the corner; east on the Upton County Line to the corner, the point of beginning.

3. ST PATRICK, PARISH, BRADY

ST FRANCIS XAVIER, MISSION, MELVIN

This parish covers the entirety of McCulloch County.

4. ST THERESE, PARISH, CARLSBAD

This parish extends over the north-west part of Tom Green County.

Begin at the intersection of the Tom Green County Line and Highway #208; thence south on #208 to #2105; west on #2015 to Highway #67; north on Highway #67 to #2288; south on #2288

to Arden Rd (#853); west on #853 to the Tom Green County Line; north on the Tom Green County Line to the next corner of the Tom Green County Line; west along the Tom Green County Line to the next corner; north on the Tom Green County Line to the next corner; east on the Tom Green County Line to the next corner; north on the Tom Green County Line to the next corner; east on the Tom Green County Line to the intersection with Armstrong St. (#208), the point of beginning.

5. ST CHARLES, PARISH, EDEN

ST PHILIP, MISSION, EOLA

OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE, MISSION, MILLERSVIEW

This parish covers the entirety of Concho County.

6. OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE, PARISH, ELDORADO

ST. PETER'S, MISSION, MERTZON

IMMACULATE CONCEPTION, MISSION, KNICKERBOCKER

This parish extends from the eastern edge of Tom Green County to the entirety of Irion County and southeast to the entirety of Schleicher County.

Begin at the northeast corner of Irion County; thence south on the Irion County Line to Highway #67; east on Highway #67 to Highway #2335; south on Highway #2335 to Franco Rd; east on Franco Rd to the unnamed Rd which is the last one you can take south; south on unnamed Rd to W Torres Rd; west on W Torres Rd until it becomes Guinn Rd; west on Guinn Rd to the Tom Green County Line; south on the Tom Green County Line to the corner; east on the Tom Green County Line to the corner; south on the Schleicher County Line to the corner; west on Schleicher County Line to the corner; north on Schleicher County Line to the corner; west on Irion County Line to the corner; north on the Irion County Line to the corner; east on the Irion County Line to the corner, the point of beginning.

7. ST THERESA OF THE CHILD JESUS, PARISH, JUNCTION

This parish covers the entirety of Kimble County.

8. SACRED HEART, PARISH, MENARD

This parish covers the entirety of Menard County.

9. ST. THOMAS, PARISH, MILES

This parish extends over the southwestern part of Runnels County.

Begin at the intersection of Highway #158 and Highway 2111; thence south on Highway #2111 to Highway #2133; southwest on Highway #2133 to Highway #67; southwest on Highway #67 to River Rd; south on River Rd until it becomes N Farm to Market #1692; south on N Farm to Market #1692 to the Runnels County Line; west on the Runnels County Line to the corner; north on the Runnels County Line to Highway #158; east on Highway #158 to the intersection with Highway #2111, the point of beginning.

10. ST BONIFACE, PARISH, OLFEN

This parish extends over the south-central part of Runnels County.

Begin at the intersection of Highway #67 and S Hickory Hill Dr; thence southeast on S Hickory Hill Dr until it becomes Highway #114; southeast on Highway #114 to Highway #83; south on Highway #83 to the Runnels County Line; west on the Runnels County Line to Highway #1678;

north on Highway #1678 to Highway #67; northeast on Highway #67 to the intersection with S Hickory Hill Dr, the point of beginning.

11. OUR LADY OF PERPETUAL HELP, PARISH, OZONA

GOOD SHEPHERD, MISSION, SHEFFIELD

This parish extends over the majority of Crockett County, and a small portion of Pecos County. Begin at the northeast corner of the Crockett County Lines; thence south on the Crockett County Line to the corner; west on the Crockett County Line to the corner; north on the Crockett County Line until you reach the intersection between Crockett County, Terrell County, and Pecos County; west on the Pecos County Line to Highway #349; northeast on Highway #349 to Southern Street (in Sheffield), west on Southern Street to Ave. K; north on Ave. K to Highway #349; northwest on Highway #349 to Interstate 10; southeast on Interstate 10 to the Crockett County Line; north on the Crockett County Line to Highway #190, east on Highway #190 to Highway #33; north on Highway #33 to the Crockett County Line; east on the Crockett County Line to the corner, the point of beginning.

12. ST JOSEPH, PARISH, ROWENA

This parish extends over the southwestern part of Runnels County. Begin at the intersection of Highway #67 and Highway #1678; thence south on Highway #1678 to the Runnels County Line; west on the Runnels County Line to River Rd (N Farm to Market #1692); north on River Rd (N Farm to Market #1692) to Highway #67; northeast on Highway #67 to the intersection with Highway #1678, the point of beginning.

13. HOLY ANGELS, PARISH, SAN ANGELO

This parish extends over the west-central part of San Angelo and of Tom Green County. Begin in the City of San Angelo at the intersection of W Houston Harte Expressway and N Howard St.; thence southeast on Howard St. to Sherwood Way; east on Sherwood Way to S Jackson St.; south on S. Jackson St. to Knickerbocker Rd.; southwest on Knickerbocker Rd out of San Angelo to the city of Knickerbocker where the road becomes S Farm to Market Rd 2335; north on S Farm to Market Rd 2335 to Highway #67; west on Highway #67 to the Tom Green County Line; north on the Tom Green County Line to Highway #853 Arden Rd; east on Highway #853 Arden Rd to Mercedes St; northeast on Mercedes St. to Glenna St; south on Glenna St. to Houston Harte Expressway; east on the Houston Harte Expressway to the intersection with N Howard St., the point of beginning.

14. SACRED HEART CATHEDRAL, PARISH, SAN ANGELO

This parish extends over the north-east part of San Angelo and Tom Green County. Begin at the intersection of Pulliam St (Highway #380) and Highway #306; thence south on Highway #306 to Paint Rock Rd. (Highway #388); east on Paint Rock Rd. (Highway #388) to Farm to Market 1692 S; north on Farm to Market 1692 S to Highway #380; east on Highway #380 to the Tom Green County Line; north on the Tom Green County Line to the corner; west on the Tom Green County Line to the corner; north on the Tom Green County Line to the corner; west on the Tom Green County Line to Highway #208; south on Highway #208 to E 14th St.; west on E 14th St. to Pecan St; south on Pecan St. to Highway #67; west on Highway #67 to N. Howard St; south on N Howard St. to Sherwood Way; east on Sherwood Way to S. Jackson St.; south on S Jackson St. to Knickerbocker Rd.; north on Knickerbocker Rd to Austin St.; North on Austin St. to W Ave. N; east on W Ave. N to Bryant St. (Highway #87); north on Bryant St.

(Highway #87) to E. Washington Dr.; east on E Washington Dr. to S Oakes St.; north on S Oakes St. to E Concho Ave.; east on E Concho Ave to Bell St.; north on Bell St. to Pulliam St (Highway #380); east on Pulliam St. (Highway #380) to the intersection with Highway #306, the point of beginning.

15. ST. JOSEPH THE WORKER, PARISH, SAN ANGELO

This parish extends over the north-west part of San Angelo.

Begin in the City of San Angelo at the intersection of Armstrong St. #208 and #2105; thence south on #208 to E 14th St; west on E 14th St. to Pecan St; south on Pecan St. to Highway #67; west on Highway #67 to Glenna St.; north on Glenna St. to Mercedes St.; west on Mercedes St. to Arden Rd. #853; west on Arden Rd #853 to Highway #2288; north on Highway #2288 to Highway #87; east on Highway #87 to #2105; east on #2105 to the intersection with Armstrong St. #208, the point of beginning.

16. ST. MARGARET OF SCOTLAND, PARISH, SAN ANGELO

This parish extends over the east part of San Angelo.

Begin at the intersection of Pulliam St. (Highway #380) and Highway #306; thence south on Highway #306 to Highway #87; west on Highway #87 to Christoval Rd (Highway 378); north on Christoval Rd. (Highway 378) to Highway #388; east on Highway #388 to S Bell St.; north on Bell St. to Pulliam St. (Highway #380); east on Pulliam St. (Highway #380) to the intersection with Highway #306, the point of beginning.

17. ST MARY’S, PARISH, SAN ANGELO

This parish extends over the south part of San Angelo and southwest part of Tom Green County.

Begin at the intersection of E Concho Ave and S Bell St.; thence south on S Bell St. to Paint Rock Rd.; west on Paint Rock Rd. to Christoval Rd.; south on Christoval Rd to Highway #277; south on Highway #277 to the Tom Green County Line; west on the Tom Green County Line to the corner; north on the Tom Green County Line Guinn Rd; east on Guinn Rd until it becomes Torres Rd; east on Torres Rd until the first unnamed road going north; north on the unnamed Rd. to Franco Rd; west on Franco Rd to Highway #2335; north on Highway #2335 until it becomes Knickerbocker Rd.; northeast on Knickerbocker Rd to Austin St.; northwest on Austin St. to W Ave. N; east on W Ave. N to Highway #87; north on Highway #87 to E Washington Dr; east on E Washington Dr to S Oakes St.; north on S Oakes St. to Concho Ave.; east on Concho Ave. to the intersection with S Bell St., the point of beginning.

18. ST ANN, PARISH, SONORA

This parish covers the entirety of Sutton County.

19. ST AMBROSE, PARISH, WALL

HOLY FAMILY, MISSION, MERETA

This parish extends over the southeast part of Tom Green County.

Begin at the intersection of Highway #380 and the east Tom Green County Line; thence south on the Tom Green County Line to the corner, west on the Tom Green County Line to Highway #277; north on Highway #277 to Highway #87; east on Highway #87 to Highway #306; north on Highway #306 to Highway #388; east on Highway #388 to Highway #1692; north on Highway #1692 to Highway #380; east on Highway #380 to the east Tom Green County Line, the point of beginning.
